RECLINK

Connects children and youth aged 4-18 in OCH neighbourhoods with free arts, sports, and camp programs; covering registration, transportation and equipment costs.



INSPIRED BY LEARNING

This year, the OCH Foundation awarded 35 post-secondary bursaries worth \$1,000 to individuals within our OCH communities. Together, we're empowering students and fostering educational opportunities.



PACK-A-SACK

Delivers school supplies and backpacks to children and youth in OCH communities, helping them return to school ready to learn. We pack over 2,000 backpacks, empowering students with the confidence to succeed.



HOP ON BIKES

Provides refurbished bicycles, helmets and locks and to tenants living in OCH. This year, we committed ourselves to distributing "A Bike a Day" to children, youth and adults living in OCH neighborhoods.



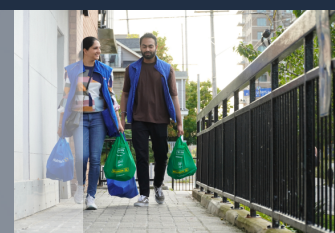
YOUTH FUTURES

A six-month bilingual mentorship program for youth aged 16-21 to develop skills for post-secondary education and employment. Offered in partnership with the City of Ottawa and BGC Ottawa.

This program addresses food insecurity by providing essential perishable, non-perishable and hygiene products. Tenant groups submit personalized requests for items to be distributed within their community.
